Egypte, Second Intermediate Period, ca 1782-1550 BCE

Glazed steatite, 1.6 x 1.1 x 0.7 cm (0 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>16</sub> x 0 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>16</sub> x 0 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>16</sub> inches)

The flat side engraved with continuous oval spiral. The iconography and discontinuous glazed with blue shade are found in the specimens of the Thirteenth Dynasty.
