**A Roman gold ring set with an onyx intaglio. Head of Apollo.**

Circa: 1st-2nd century A.D.

Gold, onyx

Intaglio : 1 x 1.25 cm (0 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>16</sub> x 0 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>16</sub> inches)

Ring: 5,24 gr ; Size 9

1st-2nd century A.D.

The hoop rounded within and without is hollowed, with broadening shoulders ending in an oval box setting set with an onyx intaglio. In the center of the stone is engraved, a head of the god Apollo facing left. He is represented with beautiful and young features, his head adorned with a band. Nice mirror polishing signs of wears on the surface of the stone and the ring.
