



A high carat gold ring set with an Italic agate intaglio. Club and weapon.

Circa: 2nd-1st century B.C.

Intaglio: $0.7 \times 0.9 \text{ cm} (0 \frac{1}{4} \times 0 \frac{3}{8} \text{ inches})$

Mounting: Gold (20k); $O^{1/2}$; total weight 4,52 gr

2nd-1st century B.C. on a later gold ring

The emblema is composed of 2 weapons: the club of Hercules and possibly a spear or harpoon, symbol of strenght and hunt. Use of globular elements. Slight wear marks.
