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Cupid is in the act of playing the lyra and advances to the right, turning his head backwards, contemplating a butterfly. This iconography refers to the allegory of Psyche (*The soul*) following Love (*Cupid*). The figure is engraved with great finesse due to the rendering of the anatomical volumes and its attributes.
