



Pair of gold earrings made of Hellenistic gold elements.

Clasps and hoops: 18k gold (750/000) and Swiss mark UGDO

Gold pendants: 22/24 k gold

H. $3.7 \times 0 \text{ cm} (1 \frac{1}{2} \times 0 \text{ inches})$

Total weight: 14,30 gr

20th clasps and hoops - Hellenistic pendants, 4th-3rd century B.C.E

Both pendants are formed by a solid rounded hoop agreemented with granulation and spherical beads. One set with a garnet. The discs on the clasp are also ancient and have been carefully re-adjusted to be part of the set. Only the clasp and the junction hoops are modern (can be easily identified by the different colour of the gold).

This beautiful pair of earrings is an example of modern adaptation of antiques jewellery elements.

Offering to these elements of the past a newlife and chance to be worn again as jewels.
