



A gold ring set with a Grand Tour carnelian intaglio. Obelisk with coat arms.

Circa: 18th century

Seal: $3.0 \times 1.8 \text{ cm} \left(1 \frac{1}{8} \times 0 \frac{3}{4} \text{ inches}\right)$

Mounting: gold (18k); UK size R; total weight 14,12 gr

French work, 18th century

A three-quarters obelisk, with a noble coat of arms on it (*to be identified*). On the base, an inscription bearing the date **1760**. On top, a ribbon coiled with the motto: **'SA DROITURE LE SOUTINT**'.

Beautiful clear engraving, originally in a seal converted into a ring (the frame is contemporary with the stone, while the rod was added later).
